<u>ACCREDITATION OF PRIOR EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING</u> <u>ASSESSMENT (APEL) – Route towards Professional</u> <u>Membership</u>

As an APEL assessor I will carry out an interview and assessment.

This service has been created to help members in the ACIOB and ICIOB grades who do not have qualifications at level 6 (no degree, higher NVQ or CMP) move towards Chartered Membership.

This APEL route is only available to current ACIOB and ICIOB members (or '2020/2021 lapsers') and will cease to exist in March 2024.

This formal route of assessment is to assess your knowledge and skills to see if they match up with the requirements. This route comprises of an interview with a CIOB assessor, who will check your knowledge and skills to determine your suitability for Professional Review, the final step to Membership.

If there are gaps in your knowledge and skills, we will advise you of this and may suggest further learning requirements.

If it is assessed as knowledge and skills met, then you will have 'passed the APEL' and you will be eligible to go on to the next step of undertake the Professional Review.

Each interview will last approximately one hour, and will be conducted over Microsoft Teams.
